



The Jacksonville Chamber of Commerce, in partnership with the City of Jacksonville, will be offering our first drive-in movie.

EVENT DATE: The event will be held on Saturday, July 18th. The movie will begin at 9:30pm. Cars will be allowed to enter beginning at 8:45pm.

MOVIE: The drive-in movie shown will be the western classic, *The Great Northfield Minnesota Raid*, which was filmed right here in Jacksonville.

ENTRY: Due to limited parking lot capacity for viewing, 30 parking spots will be raffled off, free of charge. Entries accepted Wednesday, July 8 through Sunday, July 12. Enter the raffle for a ticket using the form below.

The vehicle with the corresponding make, model and license plate number submitted by raffle winners may enter the parking lot starting at 8:45 p.m., and the movie begins at 9:30pm. **The movie is not open to the general public; only raffle winners will be admitted.**

GUIDELINES: In order to comply with State regulations, the following guidelines must be followed by raffle winners to maintain public health and safety for staff and attendees:

- The number of passengers in each vehicle must not exceed the number of available seat belts. Maximum vehicle occupancy is eight.
- Parking will be assigned by staff in order to achieve optimum physical distancing between cars and viewing optimization.
- Vehicles and passengers must remain in assigned parking stalls (except for restroom use) and must observe six-foot social/physical distance between other guests.
- The Jackson Creek Junction restrooms (located between the library and post office) will be available for use.
- To hear the movie audio, vehicles need to have a FM radio.
- Alcohol beverages, smoking, and pets are prohibited.
- **Vehicles that leave early cannot return.**



Inclement Weather Procedure

The movie cannot be shown in windy or wet conditions. In the event of inclement weather, we will post a cancellation notice on our Facebook & Instagram pages as well as our web site (jacksonvilleoregon.com) by 6:00 p.m. In the event the movie is stopped due to inclement weather or technical issues, a make-up date will be scheduled for the same attendees.

This first movie night will be used to determine if having future events will be viable.
