- Second Trolley purchase (grants, storage, contracts, logistics, services)
 - Brian D. took team out to look at the trolleys for sale, followed up on plans for maintenance and storage
 - We can use grants that have been requested for the purchase
 - Local vintners association supports a second trolley, including route that takes people to ten vineyards
 - o Storage local man has an outdoor shelter in town for a temporary spot for free
 - He also owns Buggy Car Wash, may allow us to set up a covered storage area for rent
 - Looks like there are other options
 - Need letters of support for grant generate group letters from Chamber Board and Vintner's Association
 - The board supports moving forward with a second trolley purchase
 - Amanda we need to set up more complete insurance coverage
